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## CITRUS CROP FORECAST “LIVE” COVERAGE FRIDAY, OCTOBER 10, 2014

(Southeast AgNet, Ocala, FL, October 06, 2014) The annual Citrus Crop Forecast from USDA’s National Agriculture Statistics Service (USDA/NASS) will be broadcast “live” for the 20<sup>th</sup> consecutive year at NOON Friday, October 10, 2014 on Southeast AgNet Radio Network and at [www.SoutheastAgNet.com](http://www.SoutheastAgNet.com).

AgNet’s “Live” coverage will again be anchored by Southeast AgNet founder Gary Cooper. Several grower events are planned around Florida’s citrus belt for growers to gather to tune-in to the broadcast.
