Agricultural Land Value and Cash Rent Highlights

The United States farm real estate value, a measurement of the value of all land and buildings on farms, averaged \$3,080 per acre for 2017, up \$70 per acre from 2016 values. The average value of farm real estate was up in the Southeast region. Alabama farm real estate values increased \$150 per acre (1.9 percent). Florida values were up \$300 (5.6 percent). Georgia rose \$150 per acre (4.4 percent). Farm real estate values in South Carolina were unchanged from 2016.

Cash rent paid to landlords for all cropland in the United States at \$136 is unchanged from 2016. Cash rent for pasture decreased \$0.50 per acre to \$12.50. In Alabama, cash rent for cropland in 2017 averaged \$58 per acre, an increase of \$1.00 from last year. Cash rent for cropland in Florida increased \$21 to \$123 per acre. Georgia cash rent for cropland rose \$12 to \$120 per acre. In South Carolina, cash rent for cropland for 2017 increased \$1.00 to \$46.50 per acre.
